Sumter School District's REACH Program for artistically gifted and talented students offers students in grades 3-11 opportunities to develop and enhance their talents in the areas of visual arts, theatre, and choral music through three Saturday workshops held in March, April, and May and a three-week intensive workshop in June. Students must be screened and meet criteria before qualifying for participation in this program. Students meeting qualifications to participate in the program within the past two years do not need to be referred or screened unless interested in participating in a different arts area than originally qualified for. Current qualified students do, however, need to complete the intent form emailed to them if they plan on returning to the program this year. Upon receipt of students' *Request for Screening/Referral Forms*, information will be sent to respective students in regards to the Initial Screening process and procedures.
